The America's Cup has come to San Francisco for a revolutionary 34th edition. The oldest and most coveted trophy in international sport, pre-dating the Modern day Olympics by 45 years, has been won by only four nations in the event's 160-year history.


Despite its age, the America's Cup has always been at the cutting edge of technology, innovation and boat design. For this 34th edition, teams will be racing the world's most innovative catamarans, equipped with a rigid wing over 131ft high (40m). These ground breaking sailing machines are fast and can reach twice the wind speed, exceeding at times over 40 knots (46mph).

To sum up, the 34th America's Cup will be an exciting, adrenaline high event, showcasing the best sailors on the fastest boats on the planet.


